

# Instructions: Tying Cord

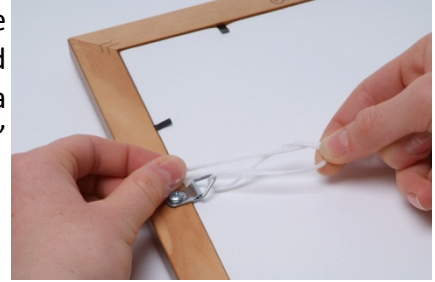

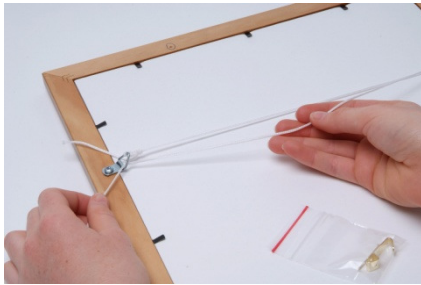
1. Screw the tri hangers into the appropriate holes for portrait or landscape hanging with the triangle ring facing inwards.



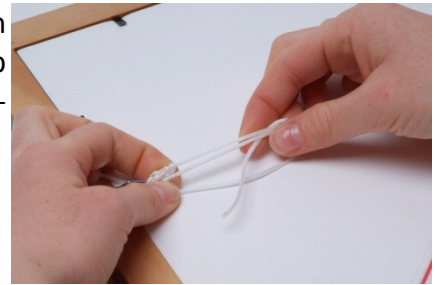
2. Tie one end of the cord to the left-hand side tri-hanger with a basic "overhand knot" repeated 3 times.



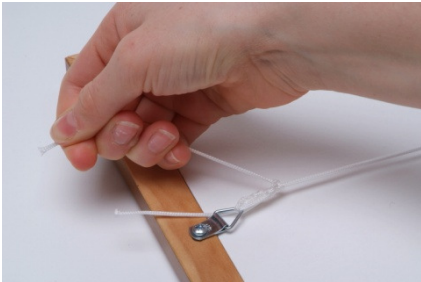
3. Feed remaining cord through the right-hand side tri hanger and back through the left-hand side.



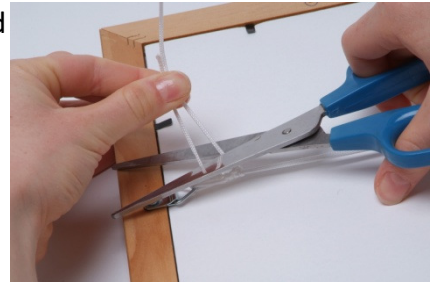
4. To maintain tension while tying off grasp both cords at left-hand side.



5. Repeat overhand knot including both cords and repeat 4 - 5 times.



6. Cut the excess cord off.



7. Ready to hang.
